YOU BELONG IN THIS COURSE IF...

..you have not yet learned the aleph-bet, vowels, or basics of Biblical Hebrew grammar.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Students will develop a basic understand of Biblical Hebrew and its building blocks. The building blocks are aleph-bet (alphabet), nikkudat (vowels) and shewa, dagesh dots, syllable identification, the definite article, indefinite articles, waw conjunction, inseparable prepositions, min preposition, and pluralization. Vocabulary will be introduced throughout. A special session will be held on the Holy Name and tetragrammaton. Students will learn be able to read and pronounce, in Hebrew, the L-rd's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13), and the Shema (Deuteronomy 6:4-5). Each session brings components of ancient and Messianic Hebrew context and culture.

Introducing Biblical Hebrew by Allen P. Ross (2001)
