COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course includes a brief review of materials covered in Biblical Hebrew 101 and moves forward with basic Hebrew grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation. New materials include pronominal suffixes on singular and plural nouns, the definite direct object, prepositions with verbal suffixes, participles, the perfect and imperfect verb paradigms, and translation exercises. New vocabulary will be introduced each week. All students will be able to read and pronounce, in Hebrew, the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13), the Shema (Deuteronomy 6:4-5), and various additional prayers that are part of the timeless Jewish liturgy contained in our Messianic Jewish Siddur. Sessions highlight components of ancient and Messianic Hebrew context and culture.
