## **BIBLICAL HEBREW 301 WINTER/SPRING 2017 COURSE DESCRIPTION**

**We meet on Saturdays, January 7 through April 1, 2016,  
from 9:00-9:50 a.m., beneath the Main Sanctuary at Messianic Jewish Congregation Beth  
Hallel, 2230 Sumpter Street, Hoover, AL, 35226.**

I. Overview. Biblical Hebrew 301 is a continuation course. This semester continues our dive into verb paradigms, translating, and applying grammatical principles to Tanakh and the Messianic Siddur.

II. Attendance and Participation. Class attendance and participation are keys to accomplishing our goals. Each session is recorded and accessible on-line for review during the week. Plan on one or two hours of study and repetition weekly. Doing a little work every day or every other day is better than doing a lot of work on just one day. Additionally, all Hebrew students are welcome in any Beth Hallel service or special event. Your understanding of the language will grow as you hear Biblical Hebrew spoken and sung through liturgy, praise, and worship.

III. Textbook. ALL Biblical Hebrew classes use Introducing Biblical Hebrew by Allen Ross, so your investment in this text will carry you through the higher level courses at Beth Hallel. Amazon carries the text for approximately \$32 new. We also encourage each student to get a copy of the Messianic Jewish Siddur, which can be purchased in the Beth Hallel Courtyard Giftshop and Bookstore for \$25. The Siddur prayers have been part of the Jewish liturgy for thousands of years, and are used as teaching examples.

IV. Instructor. We are thrilled that Yannick Wahab-Christos is returning as instructor. His heart for the Hebrew language, gifting as a teacher, and delightful sense of humor bring a very special anointing to our classes. You will receive his contact information the first day of class.
